

FIRE SAFETY INFORMATION FOR ACCOMMODATION GUESTS

Please read the following fire safety information carefully!

How to signal a fire:

Anyone staying in the accommodation area should be alerted by a loud fire alarm. The fire alarm is given to the fire brigade by the built-in fire alarm system.

In the event of a fire, the fire brigade must be informed:
Any member of staff shall be notified without delay.

Extinguishing the fire:

In all extinguishing and rescue operations, the protection of human life is the primary consideration! Guests must participate in extinguishing the fire without risk to their safety and follow the instructions of the accommodation staff regarding evacuation. Extinguishing electrical fires with water is strictly forbidden!

Fire extinguishers:

- Placed prominently throughout the building and located on each floor.

The order of leaving the accommodation:

Guests who do not participate in the signaling, extinguishing, or evacuation of the fire must immediately leave the area or part of the building at risk. Such guests should remain in the courtyard until further notice.

To ensure speed and professionalism of evacuation, clear, easy-to-understand floor plans have been posted in the rooms of the accommodation, with specific directions for evacuation. The drawings also include a text section and are interpreted in foreign languages (English + German).

Key fire safety requirements:

- 1./ Anyone who detects a fire or an immediate risk of fire must immediately report it to the receptionist. The guests of the accommodation are obliged to cooperate in the fire extinguishing and technical rescue, without compensation, with personal participation expected according to their age, health, and physical condition. The use of fire extinguishers on the premises is indicated by pictograms on the extinguisher.
- 2./ Anyone who has deliberately caused an incident requiring intervention or has deliberately given misleading signals concerning fire-fighting or technical rescue shall be liable to pay the costs incurred in connection with fire-fighting, technical rescue, and the signaling thereof. Private persons are obliged to ensure that persons under their care and supervision acquire the necessary fire safety knowledge and do not cause fire or immediate danger during their activities.
- 3./ Burning tobacco, matches, and other sources of ignition must not be placed or thrown away where they may cause a fire or explosion. In the accommodation area (the designated place), burning tobacco may only be placed in the ashtray. Smoking is only allowed in the designated area. Smoking is prohibited in the accommodation buildings.

- 4./ No heat-generating devices other than the heaters and heaters installed in the rooms may be used. No open flame lighting devices (candles, candles) may be used in the rooms.
- 5./ It is forbidden to bring into the rooms any equipment, machines, appliances, or pyrotechnic materials which are not provided for.
- 6./ For safe exit from the accommodation building, please refer to the posted floor plans and the guide. If the building is to be evacuated, the instructions of the operator must be followed.
- 7./ In the event of a fire, Guests should take only the most essential items with them when escaping and leave the building without delay. If there is also heavy smoke on the escape route, use wet cloths to protect yourself from smoke inhalation if possible. If you are trapped in the room by the fire, always close the door, also seal it with a wet cloth, but never close the door. For rooms, also consider whether escape through the window is possible (yes in ground floor rooms).
- 8./ Guests may only park their vehicles in the designated parking areas. If you are staying away for a longer period, it is recommended that you leave your car keys at the reception desk.
- 9./ The prohibitions and instructions of the warning signs and pictograms posted in the accommodation area must be observed and complied with in all cases.

STATEMENT**(for information to guests on fire safety)**

I, the undersigned, as a guest of the 'Fibula Residence Hotel & Wellness****' (7621 Pécs, Jókai u. 17-19. , 7621 Pécs, Teréz utca 9.) declare that the fire safety rules of the accommodation that apply to me were explained to me at the time of check-in, that I understand them and that I accept them as binding.

The following rules of use have been explained to me:

- 1./ Anyone who detects a fire or an imminent risk of fire must immediately report it to the receptionist or the fire brigade. Guests are obliged to cooperate in the fire-fighting and technical rescue, without compensation, with personal participation expected according to their age, health, and physical condition. The use of fire extinguishers in the accommodation area is indicated by pictograms on the extinguisher.
- 2./ Any person who has deliberately caused an incident requiring intervention or has deliberately given misleading signals concerning fire-fighting or technical rescue shall be liable to pay the costs incurred in connection with fire-fighting, technical rescue, and the signaling thereof. Private persons are obliged to ensure that persons under their care and supervision acquire the necessary fire safety knowledge and do not cause fire or immediate danger during their activities.
- 3./ Burning tobacco, matches, and other sources of ignition must not be placed or thrown away where they may cause a fire or explosion. Burning tobacco may be placed in the accommodation area only in the ashtray. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas. Smoking is prohibited inside the accommodation building!
- 4./ No other heat generating equipment may be used in the rooms other than the heaters and heaters installed in the rooms. The use of open flame lighting devices (e.g. candles, candles) is also not permitted in the accommodation.
- 5./ No fire-causing equipment, machines, appliances or pyrotechnic materials not provided for in the rooms are allowed.
- 6./ The safe exit from the building is indicated on the floor plans and in the instructions posted in the rooms. In the event of an evacuation of the building, the instructions of the operator or the emergency services must be followed.
- 7./ In the event of fire, guests should take only the most essential items with them when escaping and leave the building without delay. If there is also heavy smoke on the escape route, use wet cloths to protect yourself from smoke inhalation if possible. If you are trapped in the room by the fire, always close the door, also seal it with a wet cloth, but never lock it. In the case of rooms, also consider the possibility of escape through the window (ground floor).
- 8./ Guests are only allowed to park their vehicles in the designated parking areas. If you are away for a longer period of time, it is recommended that you leave your car keys at reception.
- 9./ The prohibition of warning signs and pictograms on the premises of the accommodation must be observed and complied with in all cases.
